1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:05 by Rob Dwyer

2. Approval of Minutes

4. Uptown Parking Garage Construction-Update

Karen Byrnes advised the Commission that construction had begun and was moving along. Once all of the shoring is complete and the larger beams are set this fall, construction will button up until spring when the concrete pour can begin. The site will “shrink” and be more contained during the winter time. There will continue to be weekly talks with the construction partners and the Commission members can be listen in on those calls. Every three weeks the neighbors in the

area will be contacted also just to see if there are new concerns. Karen also said that additional signage will be posted in the area of Park St along with a pedestrian walkway for foot traffic on the south side of the street.

5. Parking Garage Access Controls-Discussion

Karen told the Commission that there was going to be a conference call between Cardinal Tacking, CWT, and BSB Parking to try and see if we can get the systems integrated. A quote for cameras in the new garage is in the works. Karen said that she would have more detailed information after the conference call on Friday.

6. Montana Tech-Campus-Community Task Force.

Karen told the Commission that there will be a task force created to include representatives of the Butte community and Montana Tech to alleviate parking issues in the uptown area. The members will all discuss possible land swap issues and other parking solutions. A member of the Commission was asked to be on the board. Rob Dwyer volunteered to be involved with the board.
