10:10 AM BUTTE UNICOM RECIEVES A CALL FROM FRONTIER AIRLINES FLIGHT 1029 BOEING 737 ENROUTE FROM SEA TAC, IN SEATTLE, WASHINGTON TO DALLAS, TEXAS. THE PILOT REPORTS THAT THERE WAS A MID AIR BIRD STRIKE AND THEY ONLY HAVE ONE ENGINE AND THEY NEED TO DIVERT TO BERT MOONEY AIRPORT AND THEY HAVE AN EXCESS AMOUNT OF FUEL ON BOARD. THE PILOT ALSO INDICATED THAT THEY ARE CARRYING A PASSENGER THAT HAS RECENTLY BEEN TO AFRICA AND IS SHOWING SYMPTOMS OF EBOLA.

10:11 AM ALARM IS SOUNDED AND BERT MOONEY ARFF PERSONELL RESPOND.

10:12 AM 911 CENTER IS NOTIFIED OF THE IN FLIGHT EMERGENCY TO DISPATCH ALL MUTUAL AID.

10:15 AM PILOT RADIOS THAT ONE ENGINE IS COMPLETELY OUT AND HE IS EXPERIENCING A LOSS IN CABIN PRESSURE. HE REPORTS THAT THERE ARE 118 PASSENGERS AND 6 CREW MEMBERS AND HE IS APPROXIMATELY 10 MINURES FROM THE AIRPORT.

ALL BTM ARFF PERSONELL ARE IN PLACE.

10:20 PILOT RADIOS THAT HE IS ON FINAL APPROACH TO RUNWAY 15/33

10:22 FRONTIER AIRLINES FLIGHT 1029 TOUCHES DOWN AND SKIDS OFF THE RUNWAY AT THE INTERSECTION OF 15/33 AND 12/30. AIRCRAFT HAS SMOKE COMING FROM THE CABIN.
