

SECTION III

COMMUNICATION NO. 10-404

Dan Dennehy, Director, Butte-Silver Bow Public Works Department, requesting Council’s authorization to for Butte-Silver Bow to submit an application for funds through the State Revolving Fund program and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

Dan Dennehy, Director, Butte-Silver Bow Public Works Department stated this is Phase 1A of the Wastewater Treatment Plant modifications which will begin in late 2011.

It was moved by Commissioner Palmer, seconded by Commissioner Lee and passed with a unanimous verbal vote to concur with the request of Communication No. 10-404, authorize the Public Works Department to submit an application for the funds through the State Revolving Fund Program and the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and place on file.

SECTION IV

COMMUNICATION NO. 10-405

Josh Peck, Special Events Coordinator, Mainstreet Uptown Butte, requesting authorization to amend street closure time for July 3rd Chester Steel Park activities to accommodate a Family FunFest addition to the already scheduled function.

Commissioner Moodry explained he didn’t feel the Special Events Ordinance was being properly followed and further stated not all necessary signatures had been obtained.

Commissioner Moodry commented County Attorney Joyce handed him copies of the request with the necessary signatures.

It was moved by Commissioner Palmer and seconded by Commissioner Lee to concur with the request of Communication 10-405 and grant the amendment to the already scheduled function and place Communication No. 10-405 on file. The motion passed with a verbal vote of 8 yeas and 4 nays. Commissioners Morgan, Foley, Moodry and Sheehy voted nay.
