The Mile High Conservation District will revise their natural streambed and land preservation act rules governing the administration of the district's stream permitting program. The revision will include changing the time frame for an applicant to appeal the Board's decision from 15 days to 30 days per HB383 that became law during the 2019 legislative session. A public hearing will be held on Monday, November 25th at 11:00 AM at the Business Development Center (305 W. Mercury), second floor conference room to provide an opportunity to present views and submit written comments on the proposed rules.
