C. Approval of April Meeting Minutes – ES/TG

D. Items not Addressed on the Agenda – none.

E. NRDP Restoration Plans Update – Doug Martin of the Natural Resource Damage Program (NRDP) discussed the upcoming revision to the Restoration Plan and the funds that are available for projects – the estimate is \$6.5M. Given that the GSD was requested to resubmit a proposal to the NRDP for a 2–3-year work plan. The staff discussed the prioritization of the Durant Canyon Segment (2024) and the Opportunity segment (2025) as these segments have the least uncertainty, specifically access issues on ARCO owned lands. The proposal also includes funds for five years of operations, management, maintenance, and administration as well as planning and engineering expenses for future segments, to keep the project moving forward.

The NRDP will issue a draft plan for public comment and presentation to the Advisory Council in June, the Trustee Restoration Council in the fall and the Trustee, Gov. Gianforte by year end. The GSD approved the amended proposal. ES/MP

F. Construction Projects

I. Reach Q&R Construction Project

a. Submittal Status – H&H Contracting continues to make submittals and Pioneer Technical Services will be evaluating all submittals for the project.

b. Preliminary Schedule – The pre-construction conference was held on March 29. and H&H expects to start when to soil dries out. The project has a 60-day construction period. Seeding will occur in late fall.

II. Reach Q&R Update – We are still waiting for the MDT to complete Cultural Resource Assessment prior to allowing construction on the surplus property to begin. H7H is aware of this and intends to start the project from the north. to commence.

III. Durant Canyon Design /Engineering Task Order – Task Order No. 30 – Reach K-N in the amount of \$136,980.75 was presented to the Board and approved. ES/TG

G. ICMM – Dori is drafting a letter to the DEQ/EPA about the lack of an ICMM/Corridor management Plan as it relates to activities that BSB has recently conducted in the corridor.
