1. Call to Order at 12:04p.m.
2. Roll Call: Brian Holland, Lee Whitney, Abby Peltomaa, Bill McKenzie, Laurel Egan, Aubrey Jaap, and Shannon Hopewell Excused: Marissa Newman and Sara Sparks
3. Lee motions to approve the amended May 2023 Board meeting minutes, Abby seconded the motion, all were in favor.
4. Directors Report for June 2023 – see the report; certain items noted below:
 - a. Aubrey mentioned that the Play! Exhibit will be on display until the end of August. The next exhibit will be inspired by school. The team will start preparing for the next exhibit in July.
 - b. Aubrey mentioned that delivery of the ACM pay office records began today with 10 pallets. Twelve pallets remain and we will be delivered next month. Aubrey will begin going through the records upon returning from vacation.
 - c. The B’Nai Israel Temple will open July 31st for tours.
 - d. Aubrey gave an update on the new security system. Brian inquired about ongoing costs. Aubrey understood that the system will be continued to be covered by the ARPA Grant this next budget year. However, our alarm system is still operated with Photo Scan. Aubrey will follow up with this next budget year.
