

Meeting Minutes - Greenway Service District – June 13, 2019, Butte

- I. Call to Order

- III. Approval of Minutes – The Board approved the May 9, 2019 meeting minutes.
- IV. Other Items – Dori reported the sinkhole and subsidence along the trail in Reach E. She is working with DEQ and Butte's Superfund group to get it filled and the trail repaired. DEQ's Abandoned Mines Program intends to fill the sinkhole, but there is uncertainty about the trail subsidence – cause, responsibility.

Milo requested an update on the Rocker Water and Sewer surcharge. The Board discussed their concerns of the trailhead being classified as commercial. Dori is in contact with HKM and is working with BSB to come to a resolution to this issue.

- V. Project Updates

- a. Railroad Discussions:

- i. Highway 1 Project - MDT has not responded to an inquiry about additional information requested – Mike Huotte reported that Joe Walsh, MDT, is out of the office until July 7, 2019.
- ii. Reach G - Collette has completed the technical memo and preliminary drawings. Dori and Collette will contact Matt Mavrincac with Patriot about the proposal.

- b. Land Discussions

- i. Ueland Appraisal - The Board authorized Pat Reardon and Dori Skrukud to continue the discussions with the Uelands – ownership of this property is critical.
- ii. Peterson Exchange – The resolution has not been completed by the BSB County Attorney.
- iii. Butana – Alternative Route - The R/W Division of MDT provided a date and correspondence form the DL Commissions is researching the abandonment of streets and alleys in the Stuart Townsite. Further research is required to determine which streets/alleys were abandoned.
