

COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 14-29

1 A RESOLUTION FIXING THE RATE OF ASSESSMENT TO FINANCE THE COST OF
2 EACH STREET MAINTENANCE DISTRICT WITHIN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
3 BUTTE-SILVER BOW, STATE OF MONTANA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 -
4 2015 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREIN.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY AND
6 COUNTY OF BUTTE-SILVER BOW, STATE OF MONTANA:

7 SECTION 1: METHOD OF ASSESSMENT: The local government of the
8 City and County of Butte-Silver Bow hereby
9 determines that each lot or parcel of land within
10 Street Maintenance Districts One (1), Two (2),
11 Three (3) and Four (4) shall be assessed for the
12 fiscal year 2014 - 2015 for that portion of the
13 whole cost which its street frontage bears to the
14 total street frontage of the entire district,
15 exclusive of public places.

16 SECTION 2: ASSESSMENT DISTRICT ONE (1) AND DISTRICT FOUR (4):
17 Each lot or parcel within portions of the Central
18 Business District being District One (1) and
19 District Four (4) are hereby assessed \$.2695 per
20 street frontage foot for fiscal year 2014 - 2015.

1 SECTION 3: ASSESSMENT DISTRICT TWO (2): Each lot or parcel
2 within District Two (2) is hereby assessed \$.4661
3 per street frontage foot for fiscal year 2014 -
4 2015.

5 SECTION 4: ASSESSMENT DISTRICT THREE (3): Each lot or parcel
6 within District Three (3) is hereby assessed
7 \$.4771 per street frontage foot for fiscal year
8 2014 - 2015.

9 SECTION 5: MANNER OF MAINTENANCE: The maintenance work in
10 these four (4) established districts may be done
11 by contract or by forces employed by the local
12 government, or by both, in such manner as the
13 Chief Executive may elect.

14 SECTION 6: LIST OF LOTS AND PARCELS ASSESSED: A list which
15 describes each lot or parcel of land assessed
16 within the respective districts, with the name of
17 the owner thereof and the amount levied thereon
18 set opposite the lot and the owner's name, is
19 computed, extended, compiled, and stored in the
20 Management Information Services Office and is

1 available as a printed document upon inquiry in
2 the Finance and Budget Office.

3 SECTION 7: COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS: Said special
4 assessments shall be placed upon the assessment
5 rolls and collected in the same manner as taxes.

6 SECTION 8: That this Resolution shall be in full force and
7 effect from and after passage and approval.
