ORDINANCE NO. 14-13

1 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, OF THE BUTTE-SILVER BOW MUNICIPAL
2 CODE (B-SB MC) ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"; AMENDING CHAPTER
3 10.52 ENTITLED "PARKING", AMENDING SECTIONS 10.52.070, 10.52.090,
4 10.52.190, 10.52.200, 10.52.210, 10.52.240, 10.52.350, 10.52.370,
5 10.52.390, 10.52.400, 10.52.430, 10.52.450, 10.52.460, 10.52.470,
6 10.52.480, 10.52.490, 10.52.500, 10.52.510, 10.52.520, 10.52.540,
7 10.52.650, 10.52.720, 10.52.740, 10.52.790, 10.52.855, 10.52.870,
8 10.52.970, 10.52.990, 10.52.1035, 10.52.1037; REPEALING SECTIONS
9 10.52.220, 10.52.230, 10.52.250, 10.52.260, 10.52.270, 10.52.280,
10 10.52.290, 10.52.300, 10.52.310, 10.52.320, 10.52.330, 10.52.340,
11 10.52.920, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREIN.

12 SECTION 1: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
13 Section 10.52.070 of the Butte-Silver Bow
14 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
15 amended to read as follows:

16 "10.52.070 Parking or leaving vehicles on public
17 property restricted.

18 A. SAME.

19 B. It is unlawful for any person to park or
20 leave standing upon the right-of-way of any
21 street, highway or alley, or other public
22 property within the jurisdictional area of Butte-
23 Silver Bow any vehicle, including attachments
24 thereto, which has an overall length in excess of

1 two hundred twenty-eight inches (nineteen feet)
2 or an overall height in excess of ninety inches
3 (seven and one-half feet) for a period longer
4 than forty-eight hours in any consecutive seven-
5 day period. A vehicle shall be presumed to be
6 unlawfully parked or left standing if the vehicle
7 has not been relocated more than three hundred
8 feet within the specified time frame.

9 C. It is unlawful for any person to park or
10 leave standing upon the right-of-way of any
11 street, highway or alley, or other public
12 property within the jurisdictional area of Butte-
13 Silver Bow any vehicle, including attachments
14 thereto, which has an overall length in excess of
15 two hundred twenty-eight inches (nineteen feet)
16 or an overall height in excess of ninety inches
17 (seven and one-half feet) within thirty-five feet
18 of any of the following:

- 19 1. A public or private driveway;
- 20 2. An intersection; or
- 21 3. A fire hydrant.

22 D. It is unlawful to park any trailer,
23 including but not limited to travel trailers,
24 camp trailers, utility trailers, flatbed
25 trailers, and boat trailers, whether occupied or
26 not, on any street, highway or other public

1 property within the city and county of Butte-
2 Silver Bow or in any public place other than in
3 an approved trailer court or storage area for
4 more than "forty-eight" hours in any consecutive
5 seven-day period.

6 E. SAME."

7 SECTION 2: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
8 Section 10.52.090 of the Butte-Silver Bow
9 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "10.52.090 Parking for purpose of sale, repair or
12 storage.

13 A. SAME.

14 B. Provided, however, that, upon application
15 made to the parking commission by any group,
16 organization or person, the parking commission
17 may, in its discretion, waive, for a temporary
18 stated period of time, the enforcement of this
19 section as it applies to the applicant; provided
20 further, that if two-hour restricted space is
21 used the parking commission may require a fee
22 to be determined by the parking commission; and
23 further provided, that no more than two two-hour
24 restricted spaces per day are so utilized."

25 SECTION 3: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
26 Section 10.52.190 of the Butte-Silver Bow

1 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "10.52.190 Violators to report within limited
4 time. The registered owner of any motor vehicle
5 parked in violation of the provisions of this
6 chapter and for which a citation has been issued
7 as provided in Section 10.52.180 may within seven
8 days after the issuance of such citation
9 voluntarily pay the amount set by the Parking
10 Commission as bond for the specific violation for
11 full satisfaction for the particular parking
12 violation. If the registered owner of any motor
13 vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of
14 this chapter, and for which violation a citation
15 has been issued shall decline to pay such amount
16 to the parking commission within seven days after
17 the issuance of such citation, the parking
18 commission shall proceed to file a complaint
19 against such person in the city court of Butte-
20 Silver Bow. The maximum penalty for violation of
21 the provisions of this chapter shall be a fine
22 not to exceed five hundred dollars."

23 SECTION 4: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
24 Section 10.52.200 of the Butte-Silver Bow
25 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
26 amended to read as follows:

1 "10.52.200 Installation-Parking meters.

2 A. The parking director, with the approval of
3 the parking commission, may place and maintain
4 such parking control signs, signals and devices
5 as are necessary for the operation of any parking
6 meter zones when established and as required
7 under the traffic laws of the city and county."

8 SECTION 5: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
9 Section 10.52.220 of the Butte-Silver Bow
10 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and is hereby
11 repealed:

22 A. Between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:30
23 p.m., on all days except Saturdays and Sundays
24 and legal holidays, it is unlawful for a vehicle
25 to be parked in any space alongside of or next to
26 which a parking meter is located, unless the

1 meter has been placed into operation or the
2 vehicle displays a valid permit for the BSB-owned
3 parking lot in which the space is located.
4 Without a valid permit, if the vehicle remains
5 parked in the metered - parking space beyond the
6 legal parking time which is designated by a sign
7 or a signal of the parking meter showing illegal
8 parking, the vehicle shall be considered as
9 parked overtime and the parking of the vehicle
10 over time or the failure to put the meter in
11 operation, shall be a violation of this article.

6 every day between the hours of 8:30 a.m to 5:30
7 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays and legal
8 holidays."

9 SECTION 18: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
10 Section 10.52.370 of the Butte-Silver Bow
11 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
12 amended to read as follows:

13 "10.52.370 Citation for violation-Form. It shall
14 be the duty of the parking commission to issue
15 citations for violations of the provisions of the
16 parking meter and two-hour parking regulations as
17 set out herein.

18 Citations issued for violations of the parking
19 meter and two-hour parking regulations shall
20 show:

21 1. The state license number of the
22 vehicle;

23 2. Any facts, a knowledge of which is
24 necessary to a thorough understanding of the
25 circumstances attending such violation."

1 SECTION 19: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
2 Section 10.52.390 of the Butte-Silver Bow
3 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
4 amended to read as follows:

5 "10.52.390 Violators to report within limited
6 time. The registered owner of any motor vehicle
7 parked in a violation of the provisions of this
8 chapter and for which a citation has been issued
9 as provided in Section 10.52.380, may within
10 seven days after the issuance of such citation
11 voluntarily pay a fine to be determined by the
12 Parking Commission. If the registered owner of
13 any motor vehicle parked in violation of the
14 provisions of this article, and for which
15 violation a citation has been issued, shall
16 decline to pay such amount to the parking
17 commission within seven days after the issuance
18 of such citation, the parking commission shall
19 proceed to file a complaint against such person
20 in the city court of Butte-Silver Bow."

21 SECTION 20: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
22 Section 10.52.400 of the Butte-Silver Bow
23 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
24 amended to read as follows:

1 "10.52.400 Identifying posts or signs-
2 Installation.

3 A. SAME.

4 B. Posts or Signs. In the two-hour continuous
5 parking zones to be established as provided in
6 Section 10.52.460, the parking director shall
7 cause identifying posts or signs to be installed
8 upon the curb or sidewalk within the area
9 provided in Section 10.52.420. The parking
10 director shall be responsible for the regulation,
11 control, operation and maintenance of such
12 identifying posts or signs. The identifying posts
13 or signs shall indicate the lawful time period
14 during which a vehicle may be parked in a parking
15 space created herein and upon the expiration of
16 such lawful parking period the right of such
17 vehicle to occupy such space ceases and the owner
18 thereof shall be subject to the penalties
19 provided in Chapter 10.96."

20 SECTION 21: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and

"10.52.430 Unlawful parking.

A. Between the hours of 8:30 a.m - 5:30 p.m. on all days except Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, it is unlawful for a vehicle to be parked in any space within the 2-hour parking zone provided in Section 10.52.460 for a period longer than two continuous hours. If the vehicle remains parked in the parking space beyond the legal parking time which is designated by an identifying post or sign, the vehicle shall be considered as parked overtime and the parking of the vehicle over time shall be a violation of this article.

9 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby

11 "10.52.470 Two-hour continuous parking zones-Time
12 limit-Exception-Permit.

13 The maximum legal parking time for all two-hour
14 continuous parking zones, except as provided in
15 Section 10.52.450 shall be two consecutive hours;
16 provided, however, that upon application a
17 temporary permit may be issued by the parking
18 director for the extended use of parking space
19 locations in any two-hour continuous parking
20 zone.

21 A. When any contractor is required by the
22 building official to erect a protective walkway
23 extending into the parking area of the adjoining
24 street; and

1 B. When it is necessary for a contractor,
2 including a remodeling contractor, because of
3 limited space, to occupy the parking area of the
4 adjoining street with his equipment and
5 materials; and

6 C. When the parking director determines that
7 other extraordinary circumstances exist."

8 SECTION 25: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
9 Section 10.52.480 of the Butte-Silver Bow
10 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
11 amended to read as follows:

12 "10.52.480 Two-hour continuous parking zones-
13 Temporary permit-Application and issuance.

14 A. Application for a temporary two-hour
15 continuous parking zone permit shall be made in
16 writing to the parking director, who shall have
17 the discretion to grant the same and to determine
18 the period it shall run, and who shall collect
19 the fee therefor as provided in Section
20 10.52.490.

5 referred to in the preceding sections shall be
6 determined by the Parking Commission. It shall
7 apply to each vehicle or for each parking space
8 created by this chapter or twenty-five-foot
9 length of frontage if no identifying post is in
10 place."

3 seven days after the issuance of such citation
4 voluntarily pay the amount to be determined by
5 the parking commission for a two-hour continuous
6 parking violation as full satisfaction for the
7 overtime parking violation. If the registered
8 owner of any motor vehicle parked in violation of
9 the provisions of this chapter, and for which
10 violation a citation has been issued, shall
11 decline to pay such amount to the parking
12 commission within seven days after the issuance
13 of such citation, the parking commission shall
14 proceed to file a complaint against such person
15 in the city court of Butte-Silver Bow."

16 SECTION 31: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
17 Section 10.52.650 of the Butte-Silver Bow
18 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
19 amended to read as follows:

20 "10.52.650 Violators to report within limited
21 time. The registered owner of any motor vehicle
22 parked in violation of the provisions of this
23 chapter and for which a citation has been issued
24 as provided in Section 10.52.640 may within seven

1 days after the issuance of such citation
2 voluntarily pay the amount set by the parking
3 commission as bond for the specific violation for
4 full satisfaction for the particular parking
5 violation. If the registered owner of any motor
6 vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of
7 this chapter, and for which violation a citation
8 has been issued shall decline to pay such amount
9 to the parking commission within seven days after
10 the issuance of such citation, the parking
11 commission shall proceed to file a complaint
12 against such person in the city court of Butte-
13 Silver Bow. The maximum penalty for violation of
14 the provisions of this chapter shall be a fine
15 not to exceed five hundred dollars."

16 SECTION 32: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
17 Section 10.52.720 of the Butte-Silver Bow
18 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
19 amended to read as follows:

20 "10.52.720 Special uses-Fees. The following
21 special uses and charges shall apply within the
22 two hour continuous parking zones or at a metered
23 space, as designated in section 10.52.460 of the
24 city-county. All applications shall be made

1 through the office of the parking commission and
2 permits will be issued by the parking commission
3 director upon payment of required fees.

7 commercial vehicles providing service and/or
8 delivery of freight, goods, wares or merchandise,
9 requiring frequent daily business calls within

13 permit. The application shall state the name,
14 address and business of the applicant. Approval
15 of the application shall be made by the parking
16 commission director and the fee shall be
17 determined by the parking commission.

20 D. Construction Zone Parking Permit. Any person
21 or firm engaged in actual and bona fide
22 construction, including loading or unloading of
23 construction equipment and materials, for such
24 construction project within the two hour

1 continuous parking zone or at a metered space, as
2 designated in section 10.52.460 of the city-
3 county may apply for a construction parking zone
4 permit. The application shall state the name,
5 address and business of the applicant. Approval
6 of the application shall be made by the parking
7 commission director and the fee shall be
8 determined by the parking commission. Each permit
9 expires after thirty days, unless an extension is
10 granted by the parking commission.

11 1. SAME.

18 time. The registered owner of any motor vehicle
19 parked in violation of the provisions of this
20 chapter and for which a citation has been issued
21 as provided in Section 10.52.730 may within seven
22 days after the issuance of such citation
23 voluntarily pay the amount set by the parking
24 commission as bond for the specific violation for

1 full satisfaction for the particular parking
2 violation. If the registered owner of any motor
3 vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of
4 this chapter, and for which violation a citation
5 has been issued shall decline to pay such amount
6 to the parking commission within seven days after
7 the issuance of such citation, the parking
8 commission shall proceed to file a complaint
9 against such person in the city court of Butte-
10 Silver Bow. The maximum penalty for violation of
11 the provisions of this chapter shall be a fine
12 not to exceed five hundred dollars."

13 SECTION 34: Amendment: Ordinance No. 204 Section 4 and
14 Section 10.52.790 of the Butte-Silver Bow
15 Municipal Code (B-SB MC) shall be and are hereby
16 amended to read as follows:

17 "10.52.790 Violators to report within limited
18 time. The registered owner of any motor vehicle
19 parked in violation of the provisions of this
20 chapter and for which a citation has been issued
21 as provided in Section 10.52.780 may within seven
22 days after the issuance of such citation
23 voluntarily pay the amount set by the parking
24 commission as bond for the specific violation for

1 full satisfaction for the particular parking
2 violation. If the registered owner of any motor
3 vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of
4 this chapter, and for which violation a citation
5 has been issued shall decline to pay such amount
6 to the parking commission within seven days after
7 the issuance of such citation, the parking
8 commission shall proceed to file a complaint
9 against such person in the city court of Butte-
10 Silver Bow. The maximum penalty for violation of
11 the provisions of this chapter shall be a fine
12 not to exceed five hundred dollars."

17 "10.52.855 Violators to report within limited
18 time. The registered owner of any motor vehicle
19 parked in violation of the provisions of this
20 chapter and for which a citation has been issued
21 as provided in Section 10.52.850 may within seven
22 days after the issuance of such citation
23 voluntarily pay the amount set by the parking
24 commission as bond for the specific violation for

1 full satisfaction for the particular parking
2 violation. If the registered owner of any motor
3 vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of
4 this chapter, and for which violation a citation
5 has been issued shall decline to pay such amount
6 to the parking commission within seven days after
7 the issuance of such citation, the parking
8 commission shall proceed to file a complaint
9 against such person in the city court of Butte-
10 Silver Bow. The maximum penalty for violation of
11 the provisions of this chapter shall be a fine
12 not to exceed five hundred dollars."

1 commission as bond for the specific violation for
2 full satisfaction for the particular parking
3 violation. If the registered owner of any motor
4 vehicle parked in violation of the provisions of
5 this chapter, and for which violation a citation
6 has been issued shall decline to pay such amount
7 to the parking commission within seven days after
8 the issuance of such citation, the parking
9 commission shall proceed to file a complaint
10 against such person in the city court of Butte-
11 Silver Bow. The maximum penalty for violation of
12 the provisions of this chapter shall be a fine
13 not to exceed five hundred dollars."
